Rules and Registration

**ARTICLE 1: PRESENTATION**

As part of Francophonie 2026, the French Institute in India (IFI) is organizing a Grande Dictée under the theme “Travel and Escape.”

This choice reflects the desire to bring together all French speakers across the country and to highlight the work carried out by the IFI around the Indian edition of *The Little Prince*, on the occasion of the 80th anniversary of its publication, as well as to commemorate the fiftieth anniversary of the death of André Malraux.

**ARTICLE 2: TRACK – ALLIANCES FRANÇAISES (AF)**

**2.1 Target Audience**

The following are eligible to participate:

- Learners from the Alliances Françaises in India;
- More broadly, any French-speaking individual wishing to take part in the event.

**2.2 Procedures**

- Reading of a text by André Malraux with progressive difficulty, from an accessible level to a more demanding level;
- The Alliances Françaises are invited to designate a local literary figure to deliver the reading;
- By default, a teacher may conduct the reading;
- Self-correction by participants, supported by a correction guide.

**2.3 Venue**

Within the Alliances Françaises.

## **2.4 Dates**

Main date: March 17, 2026

Alternative possible dates: March 14, March 20, March 21, 2026

Certain Alliances may adapt the date according to their constraints. They undertake not to circulate the text.

The event will take place in the evening.

## **2.5 Objectives**

- To create an inclusive event for all French speakers in India;
- To encourage as many Alliances Françaises as possible to organize the event;
- To reach a wide audience nationwide and create a unifying, inclusive and stimulating gathering;
- To promote André Malraux among the French-speaking public in India.

## **ARTICLE 3 – IMAGE RIGHTS**

Participating institutions are responsible for ensuring, prior to the event, that no participant, or legal guardian in the case of minors, objects to the recording or dissemination of their image.

By organizing the dictation within their institution, they undertake to verify that the necessary conditions for taking photographs are met and that no person present has declared opposition to the use of their image.

Photographs may be taken during the Grande Dictée and used by the IFI for communication and post-event promotional purposes (website, social media, institutional materials, activity reports, etc.).

Institutions are responsible for respecting any individual objections and, where applicable, for taking the necessary measures to exclude the concerned individuals from photographs.

## **ARTICLE 4 – GENERAL PROVISIONS**

Participation in the Grande Dictée implies full and unconditional acceptance of these rules and regulations.

The IFI reserves the right to adapt the organizational arrangements if necessary.
